Resolution in support of the addition of courtesy signs on the accessible bathroom stalls across campus.

Short Title: A resolution to support adding courtesy signs to the inside and outside of the stall doors of all the accessible restrooms on the Arkansas State University campus.

Whereas,	non-able-bodied individuals have difficulties accessing the accessible stalls in each restroom on campus; and
Whereas,	able-bodied individuals are not only occupying the standard stalls, but also the only accessible stalls available; and
Whereas,	if able-bodied individuals are occupying the accessible stalls, this can be harmful to the health of those who need these stalls due to existing medical conditions; and
Whereas,	accessible stalls should only be used if you require these accommodations; and

Whereas,	there are no laws regarding who is allowed to use the accessible stalls; and

- Whereas, the courtesy signs will educate individuals on proper use of the accessible stalls; and
- Whereas, the courtesy signs will be designed by the Marketing and Communications department; and
- Whereas, according to the Assistant Vice Chancellor of Facilities Management, all costs of the courtesy signs will be covered by Facilities Management.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

- 1. Temporary courtesy signs will be placed first in the Reng Student Union, then expanded across campus.
- 2. If temporary signage is proven to work, then permanent signage will be implemented campus-wide.
