DR. C. CALVIN SMITH SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Nature and Purpose of the Award. The Dr. C. Calvin Smith Scholarship was established by the Department of History in May 2002 in honor of Dr. Smith's 32 years of service to Arkansas State University. The purpose of this scholarship is to reward the outstanding academic achievement of an African-American student in the field of social science education or history. *Preference given to BSE applicants*.

Amount and Term of the Award. One academic year (Fall and Spring semesters). Stipend will depend on current fund balance.

Eligibility. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must satisfy the following requirements:

- 1. Be an African-American student.
- 2. Be classified as a BSE Social Science or BA History major. First preference will be given to an African-American student who is pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Education degree in Social Science.
- 3. Have earned at least sophomore status.
- 4. Have at least a 2.75 overall grade point average.

Application. Students must make a formal application for the scholarship and include with their application a full college transcript, a letter of application, and the names of at least two faculty members of the History Department who have agreed to recommend them. Applicants may be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
