## Nature and Purpose of the Award.

Established by C.K. and Linda McFarland to assist high-achieving history students. C.K. McFarland was a member of the history department faculty for many years. He served as the department chair from 1971 to 1982. He retired in 1997.

Amount and Term of the Award. One academic year (Fall and Spring Semesters). Stipend will depend on current fund balance.

Eligibility. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must satisfy the following requirements:

- 1. Full-time junior entering their senior year majoring in history.
- 2. Award will be granted to applicant with the highest GPA.

**Application**. To be considered, students must make a formal application and include complete transcripts and a personal letter explaining the factors that the applicant believes would qualify him/her for the award. Applicants may be interviewed by the members of the History Scholarship Committee before the recipient is named.
