Old Business

Blackboard

Co-chair Steve Bounds reported that he attended Faculty Senate on Friday, November 20, 2015, to announce the LMS assessment project to the faculty.

Margaret Watson provided the committee with a **Proposed LMS Criterion** document to guide the selection process as the committee moves forward to lead a comprehensive and transparent campus-wide assessment process to consider potential alternative LMS solutions. The evaluation document provides a list of three high-level categories against which future LMS should be evaluated:

- LMS tools and functionality
- LMS accessibility and usability
- Consideration of AState's growth and administrative needs

The committee plans to evaluate four LMS options:

- Blackboard Learn
- Canvas
- Desire2Learn
- iTunes U

The committee plans to provide an online demonstration of the Canvas LMS to faculty to start the process of identifying must have features, desired features, and various other criteria as listed in the RFP document. Following demonstrations of alternative solutions, the committee plans to select several applications to pilot test in the Summer 2016 Second Session (July 5 - August 5). If an alternative to Blackboard Learn is identified, an additional pilot test will be conducted in Fall 2016, followed by the migration to an alternative LMS in Spring 2017, and a completed implementation in Summer 2017.

The committee plans to conduct a brief survey to learn about the needs and satisfaction levels of our faculty and instructional staff concerning their use of technology in teaching and learning.
