## Researchers Publish Studies

Dr. Jonathan Merten, associate professor of chemistry, along with undergraduate researchers Erin Nicholas, Shawnda Ethridge, Hannah Bariola, Shealyn Chestnut, Anna Anders, Jackie Brees and Marybeth Foster are coauthors of two recent journal articles published in Spectrochimica Acta Part B. With National Science Foundation funding, their work adapted astronomy techniques to measure the mass and chemical composition of transient laser-ablation plasmas.





# Sweet Presents Keynote Address to Conference

Dr. Andrew Sweet, assistant professor of evolutionary biology, gave a keynote address to the International Conference of Phthiraptera, conducted virtually. The conference involves researchers and clinicians working on parasitic lice, and included attendees from every continent except Antarctica. Sweet's presentation highlighted his research on using genetic information to untangle the co-evolutionary history between birds and their feather lice.
