# Wijeratne Receives Kays Foundation Grant

Dr. Asela Wijeratne, assistant professor of bioinformatics, submitted a successful research grant proposal to the Kays Foundation. Through his project, funded in the amount of \$16,168, Wijeratne is seeking to find a more durable and environmentally friendly solution for sudden death syndrome (SDS), which is a highly destructive soybean disease caused by the fungal pathogen, Fusarium virguliforme.

## Medina-Bolivar Describes AntiCancer Compound

Dr. Fabricio Medina-Bolivar, professor of plant metabolic engineering, is co-author of a paper published in the *International Journal of Molecular Sciences*. Sepideh Mohammadhosseinpour, a Ph.D. student in the molecular biosciences Ph.D. program, is first author. They describe a compound, isolated from peanut roots, and its effects on triplenegative breast cancer cells. They are very optimistic about the potential benefits because triple-negative breast cancer is the most difficult to treat.
