Arkansas BalloonSat Team Completes 55th Launch

Dr. Tillman Kennon, professor of science education, associate chair, and research director for Arkansas BalloonSat (ABS), along with Dr. Ross Carroll, associate professor of physics, led the team which launched a successful flight, the 55th in a series. The balloon, launched May 24 near Bayou DeView, carried research instruments to a new ABS altitude record, 105,804 feet (20.04 miles). Two instruments recorded a low temperature of -70.4F at 50,000 feet. The onboard cameras captured images and video, which the ABS team has posted online.


Harkens' New Video Released
