2010-2011 A.S. Degree (Computer & Information Technology)

1. Correct number of hours presented for degree.
2. Completed or enrolled in all required/elective courses.
3. Completed the following courses with a grade of "C" or better:
 - ENG 1003, Freshman English I**
 - ENG 1013, Freshman English II**
4. Completed HIST 2763 or 2773, U.S. History or POSC 2103, U.S. Government.
5. Completed ANTH 2233, Int./Cul. Anthropology or SOC 2213, Principles of Sociology.
6. Minimum grade point average of 2.00 overall (including transfer and ASU work) and at least a 2.00 GPA at ASU.
7. Minimum grade point average of at least 2.00 calculated on the last grade earned for each course in the major or at least a "C" for each course in the major.
8. Other requirements:
 - 16 ASU residence hours.
 - 12 of last 18 hours, ASU-Jonesboro.
 - Credit by correspondence, exam (including CLEP), evaluated military service, and USAFI not to exceed 25%. A maximum of 15 semester hours can be earned by examination.
9. File an "Intent to Graduate," card, register for graduation and pay the graduation fee when registering for the final enrollment period. (If the student is unable to graduate at the end of the term for which application has been made, a new "Intent to Graduate" form must be filed during the next term in which the student expects to graduate.)
10. Student must complete graduation requirements under the provisions of an ASU-Jonesboro catalog that is not more than seven years old at the time of the student's graduation, provided the student was enrolled in residence at a regionally accredited institution of higher education during the year the catalog was in effect. The 2010-2011 degree plan expires with the August Commencement in 2017.
