## The ASU Regional Farmers' Market will be opening May 23 with restrictions.

-Market hours will be Saturdays, 9 am till 12 pm.

-VENDORS AND CUSTOMERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS. Gloves are recommended.

-Please sanitize and/or wash your hands before entering the market.

-We will not be offering wooden tokens at this time. PLEASE BRING EXACT CHANGE IF YOU ARE PAYING WITH CASH. Some vendors will also accept debit cards.

-We will still offer EBT tokens to our SNAP customers, which will be sanitized after each market.

-We will count customers as they enter and exit the market, allowing 25 customers at a time. -Customers will line up at the entrance, six feet apart. The line will wrap around the east side of the pavilion.

-The walkway through the pavilion will be divided with rope/tape. Customers will enter at the front of the pavilion and walk one way through the market. At the end of the pavilion, customers will turn and come up the other side, exiting out the front.

-Vendors will have six feet of space between their booths and vendors will set up their booths farther back in the bay to make the walkway wider for customers.

-Vendors must have an empty table at the front their booth. All products must be behind the empty table. The vendor will handle all products until the customer has purchased them.

-Customers must remain stay 6 feet away from each other.

-Please bring a list and shop alone. Preferably only person from a household.

-Talk to your favorite vendors about preordering so you do not have to spend as much time at the market.

-Pets will not be allowed (This does not include service animals).

-All educational programs and music events have been cancelled until further notice.

-We will not open the Tuesday market on the first Tuesday in June, as we usually do. I will let you know as soon as we have our Tuesday market schedule.
