Pepper 'Whopper' sweet Bell

'Whopper' Jap - hot

- **Whopper – Sweet Bell:** Days to Maturity: 70
- Fully 4-inches-across and 4-inches-long, this giant main-season bell is unsurpassed for appearance as well as taste. fruits have very thick walls and a sweet, juicy, crisp, and tender flavor perfect for raw or cooked eating.
- Plants bear excellent yields, their foliage shielding the fruit from sunscald. As the peppers mature, they turn from bright green to red and the flavor sweetens still further. Resistant to tobamo po virus and bacterial leaf spot
- **Whopper Jalapeno:** Days to Maturity: 72
- highly productive, easy to grow, absolutely delicious Jalapeño that stands up to just about any disease
- pungent little dark green pepper - Very popular fresh, canned, or pickled, it livens up any dish.
- Weighing in at 1.8 to 2.6 ounce each, these peppers pack 2100 to 2500 Scovilles of heat. Best of all, the plants are highly resistant to most pepper diseases, especially potato virus UY, tomato etch virus, canker stem, and root rot (Phytophthora).



Squash Enterprise (yellow)

- Days to maturity: 41 days.
- Enterprise has it all -- wide adaptability, terrific yields, and great holding ability!
- The straight, slender yellow fruit measures 7 to 8 inches long and 1 to 2 inches wide. The flavor is mild, savory, and creamy-sweet. This is the straightneck you will want for great eating all summer long.
- A growers' favorite in the south, these vigorous bushes bear high-quality fruit across multiple harvests. A great choice for any region of the country, with terrific yields of top-notch eating. It is trouble free and very adaptable, no matter what kind of soil or weather your garden has.
- Summer squash ripens during the hot summer months. Thin-skinned, is best eaten fresh. Sow seeds 1 inch deep directly into the garden after the danger of frost is past. Thin the seedlings to 24 inches apart, or plant several seeds in hills 4 feet apart and then thin to 2 plants per hill (for even earlier harvests, start seeds indoors). Pick when the fruits are still small (4 to 8 inches long).



Zucchini – ‘Spineless Beauty’

- Days to Maturity: 43 from direct-sowing
- No more scratched arms or damaged fruit from gingerly poking among sharp spines to harvest the zucchini! Spineless Beauty hybrid offers excellent yields of uniform, medium green fruit on open plants with very few spines. A classic favorite that has stood the test of time, it belongs front and center in your summer squash garden.
- Spineless Beauty hybrid is the industry standard for zucchini for so many reasons. Harvesting it is simple, living up to the promise of its name. But it also matures quickly, offers very uniform fruit, and has a tender, juicy, flavorful bite that everyone loves. And the yields are very high on vigorous plants.
- Expect these creamy fruits to reach 8½ inches long and about 1½ inches wide, with a dark green color, smooth texture, and slight ribbing. They are very uniform, making canning a snap. And the flavor is just unbeatable!

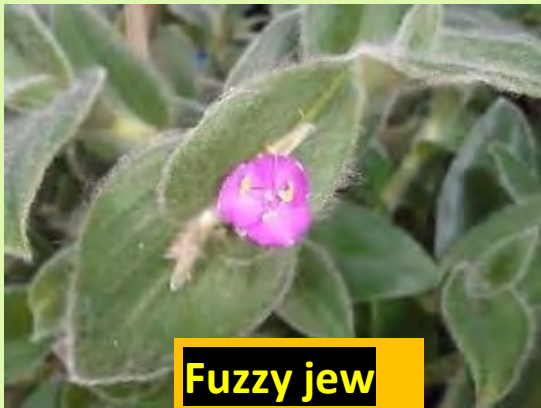
