Checklist for BSN Admissions
1. <u>If you are not currently an A-State Jonesboro student</u> you must <u>first</u> apply for admission to A-State: http://www.astate.edu/info/admissions/index.dot
2. Apply for admission to the BSN Program. Submit electronically the online application at http://www.astate.edu/college/conhp/departments/nursing/index.dot and are available online April 30 th – June 7 th for Fall and August 31-Oct 15 for Spring Admissions. NOTE: This is a separate application from the University Admissions application. If you are currently not an A-State Jonesboro student , you will need to complete both applications. If you area currently an A-State Jonesboro student, you will only complete the BSN Program Application.
3. Take the Nursing Entrance Exam. The exam given is the HESI A2 – 5 sections, Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary, Anatomy & Physiology, Math and Critical Thinking. Information to schedule for the exam is located on the School of Nursing website. Exam fee is non-refundable.
4. <u>Submit all transfer course work</u> to the A-State Registrar's Office by May 25th for Fall admissions; Sept 15 for Spring admissions.
5. If you were born in a foreign country, a test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a minimum score of 83 on the Internet based test is required. http://www.ets.org/toefl. Submit official scores to the A-State Registrar's office.
6. If you previously attended a Nursing Program that you did not complete, you must have the program Dean/Director send a letter stating your standing when you left the program. Arkansas State University, School of Nursing Attn: BSN Admissions Committee P.O. Box 910, State University, AR 72467
7. If you are Spanish proficient (Praxis II-Spanish: World Language – minimum score of 168, OPI – minimum score of "Advanced Low"), you must send official, sealed scores to the School of Nursing at: Arkansas State University, School of Nursing Attn: BSN Admissions Committee P.O. Box 910, State University, AR 72467

^{**}Class size is limited and all applicants may not be accepted into the program. Interested individuals are encouraged to seek an advisor early in their college career to ensure that all prerequisites are completed in a timely manner.

BSN Admission Requirements

Students must have at least 30 semester hours with a **cumulative GPA of 3.0** or above and a pre-requisite GPA of 3.0 or above completed by the application deadline.

- Spring admission October 15

- o BIO 2203/2201 Human Anatomy & Physiology I & Lab
- BIO 2223/2221 Human Anatomy & Physiology II & Lab

Courses below may be substituted for the above sciences:

- o BIO 2103/2101 Microbiology for Nursing & Allied Health & Lab
- o CHEM 1043/1041 Fundamental of Concepts of Chemistry & Lab

All prerequisite course work must be completed by the June 7th application deadline for Fall Admission.

To be considered for Spring admission, all prerequisite course work must be completed or provide proof of enrollment by October 15 deadline
