

**Arkansas State University-Jonesboro
Concurrent Program Admission Standards
Academic Year 2021 - 2022**

All students must have **completed the 8th grade, a minimum ACT composite score of 19, an ACT reading score of 19, and a minimum high school GPA of 2.75 for admission to the CEP.** An ASPIRE reading score of 428 **OR** ACCUPLACER reading score of 253 may be used as an equivalency for ACT scores. Enrollment in English composition and math courses are subject to the required subtest scores noted below.

***An ACT Math score of 19 is allowed for placement based on meeting seat hour requirement for 5-day week attendance.
