Act 456 Concurrent Lottery Scholarship*

The Arkansas Concurrent Challenge Scholarship Program (commonly referred to as Act 456) provides a maximum of 12 hours of reduced college tuition for high school juniors and seniors. Since the A-State tuition rate is already reduced for concurrent enrollment students, the tuition will be waived for a maximum of 12 hours of credit for Act 456 eligible students.

- Courses eligible for Act 456 must be on the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS) list**
- Successful completion of courses (final grade of "C" or better) is required to continue full scholarship award amount.
- Online courses are eligible for the scholarship.
- Student success plan must be on file at the high school.
- Counselor provides certification of eligibility and enrollment to the Concurrent Enrollment Program for each student.
- Tuition charges will remain on the student's account until all Act 456 waivers have been applied. Therefore we suggest that as soon as a bill is received, the tuition should be paid. Once the money comes from the state of Arkansas, a refund will be issued.
