SEVIS ID

What is a SEVIS ID?

Your SEVIS ID is a number found on the top section of the I-20 and needed to complete processes like paying for your SEVIS I-901 fee and making your visa appointment. It is important to use the SEVIS number of the school you intend to attend. It will start with N00. The I-20 is not a visa.

When is the earliest I can arrive in the US?

The I-20 shows the earliest you can arrive is 30 days prior to the start date on your I-20. Please plan travel accordingly as you may have to find your own accommodation until the start date on the I-20. Housing on campus may not be available if you arrive early. If you cannot arrive by the start date, please contact us for a deferral request. This must be done within 30 days of the start date of the I-20 or your record could be cancelled.
